In order to meet the various needs of our international community, AMDA's GAP Performing Arts program is offered in both 8-week and 3-week program sessions. The 8-week program is offered each Fall, and the 3-week program offered in Winter, Spring, and Summer. Each program features essential core classes dedicated to the development of fundamental performing arts techniques with choice courses offered in areas of interest and specialization. All participating GAP students will also be reviewed and considered for admission and scholarship to AMDA College of the Performing Arts.

Classes may include: acting for stage and screen, movement, writing, stage combat, monologue preparation, and self-tape/on-camera audition techniques
